AGGRESSIVELY SEEKING PARTNER

Newfoundland – With the backing of a newly appointed, heavily credentialed Advisory Committee and a property he describes as “one of, if not the most exciting base metal prospects in Eastern Canada,” Brian Dalton is confident his junior exploration company will soon find an investment partner. Dalton, the President and CEO of St. John’s-based Altius Minerals Corporation, refuses to compare his Lockport property to the Voisey’s Bay nickel find but he will say that it is an interesting find with a cross-section of massive sulphides. He is so confident about the potential of the deposit that he finds it extremely difficult to resist the temptation to put all his company’s resources into advancing the project.

That temptation is lessening thanks to his Advisory Committee whose members are quickly helping Dalton make the right connections with major mining companies and cash-rich explorers.
