Casey says hard to believe, Altius keeps getting better

Douglas Casey, writing in the July 1, 2005, edition of his *International Speculator*, refreshes his buy of Altius Minerals Corp. at \$3.60. Mr. Casey said buy four times between September, 2001, and April, 2005, at prices from 51 cents to \$3.44. An investment of \$1,000 each time would be worth \$10,811 today. The globe-hopping letter writer calls Altius an outstanding junior explorer pursuing the generative model, focusing its considerable technical expertise on Canadian prospects. The company has about 20 properties in its portfolio, eight of which are currently under active joint ventures. The most recent JV announced was with gold and uranium mining junior Aflase of South Africa. The parties have agreed to work together to provide advisory and consulting services to one another, and to collaborate in the acquisition and development of properties and projects in Canada. The intention is to focus on Altius's uranium properties in Canada. Altius has been exploring for uranium in Eastern Canada since 2001. Its current uranium portfolio includes interests in the district-scale Central mineral belt of Labrador, the subject of a \$5-million program this summer with Fronteer Development Group Inc.
